I believe that my experience with Future Leaders of America and my church has also allowed me to connect with people from all walks of live who have different lived experience, points of view and values. Due to our community being so diverse, I believe that we should always lead with the question of "what are their needs?" in order to ensure to that the community members have the resources they need to thrive. As a Community College educator, I have also been able to develop relationships with students from different backgrounds which has allowed me to see that each person and community has needs that are important to them and that as life events happen those changes will evolve and change.

To be a part of this commitee, it is important to keep in mind the diverse needs of the community. I still recall when the city began the conversation of redistricting in 2017. Being a part of the city forums was so interesting because I was able to see first hand how the committee balanced out the needs of each community and negotiated how the resources are distributed. Keeping all of that in mind, now that I am back in my community after recieving my Bachelors degree and Master's degree, I want to give back to the community that has given me so much. I believe that it is that empathy, care, passion and love for my community that will be an asset being a part of the community. Through this committee, I hope to use my privilege and love for the community to advocate for the resources the community needs.

I was born and raised in Santa Barbara, and am a proud graduate of our public education system (go Dons!) I hold degrees in Sociology and East Asian Studies from Brown University, where I learned first-hand the importance of functioning local governments and bipartisan collaboration.
As an active citizen, I follow local issues closely, have voted in almost every Santa Barbara election since I was eligible, even out of state at college, thanks to absentee ballots. I spend quite a bit of time before each election doing in-depth research on each local and state ballot measures, and am often the person that my friends come to decipher difficult-to-understand propositions or convoluted federal and state mandates.
My background as a research sociologist is a natural match for this commission as I have experience parsing large quantities of demographic data, remaining objective in order to ethically conduct research in social settings, and understanding the important demographic and social makeups of individual districts.
As a life-long Santa Barbara resident, I am aware of and very appreciative of the diversity and depth of this community, as well as the character and history of individual neighborhoods and their surrounding districts.
I also have experience in leadership positions and committees, and am currently a Co-Chair of the ELP Alumni Council, which hosts professional development events and opportunities for graduates of Leading From Within's Emerging Leaders Program for nonprofit leaders (my term will end by February of 2021).
I have a strong belief that decisions made for the people should involve the people - the redistricting process should be accessible to all community members in Santa Barbara county regardless of geographic location, language barriers or lack of access to technology. I will work to advocate for transparent decision-making, accessible meetings, and research-backed solutions.

My family has been ranching in California since the early 1800's. My Dad and I ran our own cattle operation together for nearly 30 years. In that time, we leased ranches in Gaviota, Lompoc, Buellton, Los Olivos, Santa Ynez, Los Alamos, Orcutt, and Santa Maria. We also ran a receiving station in Buellton where we helped local ranchers facilitate the transportation of their cattle to the Livestock Market in Templeton. These ventures afforded us the opportunity to familiarize ourselves with even the most remote areas of the County and also provide a service for fellow ranchers.

Prior to taking on our family's cattle operation full time, I worked as a food server at various restaurants in Santa Maria to earn money and put myself through school. This experience in the service industry taught me valuable lessons in people skills! After college, I was a bookkeeper for 5 years at a row crop farming company in Guadalupe.

Santa Barbara County is a beautiful and economically diverse area that is rich in history tradition. Our County boasts a number of large cattle ranches, ranchettes, hobby farms, wineries and vineyards, row crop farming operations, beach front properties, popular tourist destinations, and most recently, cannabis operations. While I value the history and traditions of Santa Barbara County, I completely understand that change is inevitable and, when "handled" correctly, can be a positive thing. My own home town of Los Alamos, once referred to as a "sleepy little western town" dominated by cattle ranching and dry farming, is now surrounded by vineyards and cannabis operations and considered to be a popular tourist destination with trendy restaurants! The diversity that makes this area so unique can also create challenges when trying to ensure that all residents and their interests are adequately represented. Responsible redistricting is a way to make this possible and I would love to be a part of this significant decision making process.

My family has deep roots in Santa Barbara County. My Great Great Great Grandfather, Jose de la Guerra, was commandante of the Presidio of Santa Barbara from 1815 to 1842. He was an influential man at the time and acquired several thousand acres of land through purchases and land grants. Portions of these original land grants in Cuyama and Lompoc are still owned by family members and currently operate as cattle ranches.

The Oreña Adobe in Santa Barbara, originally constructed by Jose de la Guerra in 1849, was purchased in 1858 by Gaspar Oreña after he married De la Guerra's daughter, Maria Antonia. Gaspar Oreña and Maria Antonia were my Great Great Grandparents. Fortunately, my family maintains possession of this Adobe.

Judge John T. Rickard, who served as mayor of Santa Barbara from 1953 – 1956, was my uncle. "Uncle Jack", as we fondly referred to him as, also served as City Harbor Commissioner and as City Attorney of Santa Barbara. He was instrumental in revitalizing Old Spanish Days Fiesta, after it had been "placed on hold" during World War II and because of the subsequent droughts experienced in Southern California. Uncle Jack loved Santa Barbara and was proud of his years of service to the city.

I am interested in serving on the County of Santa Barbara Citizens' Independent Redistricting Commission because I want to help establish fair electoral districts in Santa Barbara County. I am thoroughly informed as to the profound implications of electoral districts for fair (representative) democracy, and I am a big proponent of partisan-balanced redistricting committees. I have interests and expertise that are particularly relevant to serving on the Commission.

I am a Geography Professor at the University of California, Santa Barbara (UCSB), and I am professionally interested in political geography, the role of geography in attitudes and identity formation, and the geography of regions, including administrative regions like electoral districts. I am particularly interested in redistricting and well versed in the phenomenon of gerrymandering, which is powerful and fascinating. I have abundant analytical skills that are directly relevant to activities of the Redistricting Commission. including expertise in data analysis, social surveys (including the Census), mapping, and geographic information systems (GIS). I have been on the faculty of the Department of Geography at UCSB, one of the country's highest ranked geography departments, since 1992. I teach a course on human geography (GEOG 5) every year and have for over 20 years. Human geography includes population, demography, migration, economic geography, urban geography, political geography, and more. I also teach a course on the regional geography of the United States (GEOG 150) annually and have for nearly 20 years; this course includes a significant portion specifically about California. I have also taught courses in statistical data analysis and research methods for over 20 years. I coauthored the textbooks for all three of these courses. I have studied and written about geographic regions and regionalization. authoring or coauthoring a handful of articles and chapters on these topics; for example, in 2017, my doctoral student Daniel Phillips and I published "Defining the Community of Interest as Thematic and Cognitive Regions" in the academic journal Political Geography. I am very familiar with geographic information systems (GIS), which are used to assist in the process of redistricting. I am internationally recognized as an expert on how people perceive and reason with map information and GIS. I am currently Co-Editor-in-Chief of the academic journal Spatial Cognition and Computation. As a Professor of Geography and instructor of human geography, I have extensive knowledge about Santa Barbara County's (and California's and the US's) demographic and geographic diversity, including its ethnic and racial groups; its socioeconomic and occupational groups; its economic activities; its physical features, including climates, landforms, and vegetation; and its urban, rural, and wilderness landscapes.

My professional activities over the years provide ample evidence of my ability to work with others and provide leadership. I served as Vice-Chair of UCSB's Department of Geography from 1996 to 2005 and Chair from 2014 to 2016. I was Assistant Dean of Undergraduate Education at UCSB's College of Letters and Science from 2005 to 2009. I have served on several campus committees, including the Campus Elections Committee, the Public Safety Committee, the Student Affairs Council, the Student Fee Advisory Committee, the Executive Committee of the College of Letters & Science, and both the Undergraduate and Graduate Councils. I served as Vice-Chair of the UCSB Faculty Club Board of Directors in 2005. I helped create the UCSB Graduate Emphasis in Cognitive Science, served on its Steering Committee from 1996 to the present, including Chairing it from 1999 to 2005. I have also served as Vice-Chair/ Chair/Past Chair and Academic Director of the Environmental Perception and Behavioral Geography Specialty Group of the Association for American Geographers (AAG).

The depth and sincerity of my desire to serve is further evidenced by a variety of volunteer activities I have participated in over the years. I have given presentations at area K–12 schools nearly every year for over 20 years, as part of National Geography Awareness Week. I have given free lectures at the Map Society of California meeting in Santa Barbara, the UCSB Faculty Club, and the Rotary Club of Carpinteria. I have served as a volunteer judge several times at both the Santa Barbara County and California State Science Fairs. I recorded textbooks for the Santa Barbara Unit of Learning Ally (formerly Recording for the Blind & Dyslexic), served as volunteer escort at Cottage Hospital, and led the organization of "Space for Dinner," a group of UCSB faculty, staff, and students who purchased, prepared, and served dinner once a month at the Emergency Shelter of the Transition House in Santa Barbara (the pandemic has put that on hold).

In sum, I have a great deal of professional experience with oral and written communication, and in presenting complicated materials to audiences of various cultural and educational backgrounds. Finally, I am moderate politically (having always been registered as NPP in California) and believe in the great importance of maintaining dialogue and mutual respect among stakeholders with different political views.

My professional and community experiences can help me redraw voting district lines to ensure that all of Santa Barbara County's diverse communities are represented in local politics.

Professionally, I am an Associate Professor of Sociology for Brandman University. As a sociologist, I am keenly aware of how the apparently independent decisions of individuals are actually greatly influenced by social and political factors and forces. I have also learned what questions to ask and what data to analyze to find out what those sociopolitical factors and forces are. For example, I was informally asking and analyzing why some Santa Barbara communities are more vulnerable to COVID-19 than others before local media revealed that undocumented agricultural workers and incarcerated individuals (nearly all of whom are people of color) are more susceptible to the virus because they are not able to work from home nor socially distance (http://www.santamariasun.com/news/19892/farmworkers-in-santa-barbara-and-san-luis-obispo-counties-remain-vulnerable-as-the-covid19-crisis-continues/).

Also, as a local educator, I am always learning from others. Many of the working adult students I have taught during the past nine years—both in my hybrid (part online, part in person) classes on Brandman's Santa Maria campus and in my fully online classes—are from Santa Barbara County. They have educated me about local communities, as I have not grown up in the county. I have learned from them some of Santa Maria's specific needs, such as having more K-12 teachers from the city or county instead of from San Luis Obispo County, and also a more bilingual (Spanish-English) workforce, in addition to more jobs for those who are not Spanish-English bilingual. Helping to redraw voting districts so that county residents are better able to elect representatives who can make sure these needs are met is one way I can work to address these needs.

Additionally, I have been active in community organizations that have given me firsthand insight into local, County needs. Serving as a community volunteer for Santa Barbara County Education Office's Partners in Education organization since 2013 has allowed me the opportunity to speak in classrooms throughout the county about college and my career. In those classrooms, I hear our youth's concerns about their communities. They want to foster more respect for public facilities and spaces, the environment, and for each other. And they are our future voters. I want to help make voting as accessible as possible for them so their voices and concerns are heard.

Moreover, I am currently the 2020-2021 Co-President Elect of the Santa Maria Branch of the American Association of University Women (AAUW). As the organization is currently celebrating the centennial anniversary of the 19th amendment and U.S. women's right to vote, I have been learning (and informally educating others) that this right did not extend to all women of color until 1965; and many women of color nationwide still face barriers to voting. I want to do my part to help make sure no such barriers exist in Santa Barbara County.

Personally, as a South Asian American woman who has lived in many different parts of the nation and spent a considerable amount of time in Latin American and India, I have learned through experience what it means to respect diversity—namely, how to practice cultural humility and really listen to others on their terms without assuming to know what others need. Also, I have learned how to do this in more than one language, as I am proficient in Spanish and also have a basic, conversational knowledge of Tamil (a South Indian, Dravidian language). I believe that cultural humility and active listening, as well as asking the right questions when appropriate, are important skills and experiences that I can bring to the Commission to help redraw voting districts in ways that are fair to all of Santa Barbara County's communities.

Recently, I helped to organize and facilitate a webinar through my university on the importance of Census 2020 data for all communities. The webinar featured speakers from Kern County who work for the Census Bureau and for non-profit organizations in the county. It was from these speakers that I learned the importance of Census 2020 data for redistricting. As a sociologist, I already knew the importance of census data for academic research. But I didn't realize its importance for redistricting, specifically, until the webinar. Now I am excited that I may possibly be able to apply Census 2020 data not only in my research but also in ways that help to improve my local community and County. As I learned from the webinar speakers, Census 2020 data are particularly significant because, for the first time, respondents can write in their ethnic identities in addition to indicating their racial identities. As a result, we will have more data on our nation's and county's diversity than ever before.
