A couple of weeks ago, I started following the progress of the redistricting commission. I am concerned that the ordinance is not being followed to the letter.

The most current issue has to do with the commission voting to award the counsel contract to Fred Woocher, despite the fact that he is clearly disqualified from serving having been Supervisor Farr's attorney on an election matter within the 8 year prohibition.

The second issue has to do with filling vacancies. Ms. Katz resigned on Feb 2. The next meeting, that will involve interviewing for her replacement, is not scheduled until Feb 22, despite the fact that the ordinance requires vacancies to be filled within 10 days.

Both of these items have been brought to the attention of Mr. Churchwell who is currently advising the commission.


The Redistricting ordinance clearly states that no consultants who have worked for a county supervisor/candidate's election in the past 8 years can be a consultant to the rediscricting commission
