As you prep for our meeting Wednesday evening, I would particularly encourage you to spend some time on agenda item 6b and 6c (also reference pages 19-21 of the meeting agenda packet).

We have worked diligently for several months now to seek input from our communities about communities of interest and other considerations they would like us to use in evaluating and ultimately selecting the map that will govern supervisor elections for the next 10 years. While we're still at the end of the "input gathering" process, it is time that we start to synthesize what we have heard and express it in the form of themes that our staff can use to help in the initial review and organization of submitted maps.

My hope is that, during this agenda item, each of the commissioners will reflect on the key themes and input that you have heard, either in public hearings, workshops, or other interactions you have had during the past few months.
